Introduction

The Forrow is an information technology and cybersecurity consultancy.

We understand that you are aware of and care about your own personal privacy interests, and we take that seriously. This Privacy Notice describes the Forrow's policies and practices regarding its collection and use of your personal data, and sets forth your privacy rights. We recognize that information privacy is an ongoing responsibility, and so we will from time to time update this Privacy Notice as we undertake new personal data practices or adopt new privacy policies.

How we collect and use (process) your personal information

Forrow collects personal information about its website visitors and customers. With a few exceptions, this information is generally limited to:

- name
- job title
- employer name
- work address
- work email
- work phone number

We use this information to provide prospects and customers with services.

We do not sell personal information to anyone and only share it with third parties who are facilitating the delivery of our services.

From time to time, Forrow receives personal information about individuals from third parties. Typically, information collected from third parties will include further details on your employer or industry. We may also collect your personal data from a third party website (e.g. LinkedIn).

Use of the Forrow Website

As is true of most other websites, Forrow's website collects certain information automatically and stores it in log files. The information may include internet protocol (IP) addresses, the region or general location where your computer or device is accessing the internet, browser type, operating system and other usage information about the use of Forrow's website, including a history of the pages you view. We use this information to help us design our site to better suit our users' needs. We may also use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server and to administer our website, analyze trends, track visitor movements, and gather broad demographic information that assists us in identifying visitor preferences.

Forrow has a legitimate interest in understanding how members, customers and potential customers use its website. This assists Forrow with providing more relevant products and services, with communicating value to our sponsors and corporate members, and with providing appropriate staffing to meet member and customer needs.

Sharing information with third parties

The personal information Forrow collects from you is stored in one or more databases hosted by third parties located in the EU. These third parties do not use or have access to your personal information for any purpose other than cloud storage and retrieval. On occasion, Forrow engages third parties to send information to you, including information about our products, services, and events.

We do not otherwise reveal your personal data to non-Forrow persons or businesses for their independent use unless: (1) you request or authorize it; (2) it's in connection with Forrow-hosted and Forrow co-sponsored conferences and we have a legitimate reason to do so; (3) the information is provided to comply with the law (for example, compelled by law enforcement to comply with a search warrant, subpoena, or court order), enforce an agreement we have with you, or to protect our rights, property or safety, or the rights, property or safety of our employees or others; (4) the information is provided to our agents, vendors or service providers who perform functions on our behalf and we have legitimate reason to do so; (5) to address emergencies or acts of God; or (6) to address disputes, claims, or to persons demonstrating legal authority to act on your behalf. We may also gather aggregated data about our services and website visitors and disclose the results of such aggregated (but not personally identifiable) information to our partners, service providers, advertisers, and/or other third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

Transferring personal data to the U.S.

Forrow has its headquarters in the UK. Information we collect about you may be processed in the United States. By using Forrow's services, you acknowledge that your personal information may be processed in the United States. The United States has not sought nor received a finding of "adequacy" from the European Union under Article 45 of the GDPR. Pursuant to Article 46 of the GDPR, Forrow is providing for appropriate safeguards by entering binding, standard data protection clauses, enforceable by data subjects in the EEA and the UK. These clauses have been enhanced based on the guidance of the European Data Protection Board and will be updated when the new draft model clauses are approved.

Depending on the circumstance, Forrow collects and transfers to the U.S. personal data with your consent; to perform a contract with you; or to fulfill a compelling legitimate interest of Forrow in a manner that does not outweigh your rights and freedoms. Forrow endeavors to apply suitable safeguards to protect the privacy and security of your personal data and to use it only consistent with your relationship with Forrow and the practices described in this Privacy Statement. Forrow also enters into data processing agreements and model clauses with its vendors whenever feasible and appropriate. Since it was founded, Forrow has received zero government requests for information.

Data Subject rights

The European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and other countries' privacy laws provide certain rights for data subjects. Data Subject rights under GDPR include the following:

- Right to be informed
- Right of access
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure

- Right of data portability
- Right to object
- Rights related to automated decision making including profiling

This Privacy Notice is intended to provide you with information about what personal data Forrow collects about you and how it is used.

If you wish to confirm that Forrow is processing your personal data, or to have access to the personal data Forrow may have about you, please contact us.

You may also request information about: the purpose of the processing; the categories of personal data concerned; who else outside Forrow might have received the data from Forrow; what the source of the information was (if you didn't provide it directly to Forrow); and how long it will be stored. You have a right to correct (rectify) the record of your personal data maintained by Forrow if it is inaccurate. You may request that Forrow erase that data or cease processing it, subject to certain exceptions. You may also request that Forrow cease using your data for direct marketing purposes. In many countries, you have a right to lodge a complaint with the appropriate data protection authority if you have concerns about how Forrow processes your personal data. When technically feasible, Forrow will—at your request—provide your personal data to you.

Reasonable access to your personal data will be provided at no cost. If access cannot be provided within a reasonable time frame, Forrow will provide you with a date when the information will be provided. If for some reason access is denied, Forrow will provide an explanation as to why access has been denied.

Data storage and retention

Your personal data is stored by the Forrow on its servers, and on the servers of the cloud-based database management services the Forrow engages, located in the Global AWS platform. The Forrow retains service data for the duration of the customer's business relationship with the Forrow and for a period of time thereafter, to analyze the data for Forrow's own operations, and for historical and archiving purposes associated with Forrow's services. Forrow retains prospect data until such time as it no longer has business value and is purged from Forrow systems. All personal data that Forrow controls may be deleted upon verified request from Data Subjects or their authorized agents.
